Roberto Clemente Charter School-Parent Compact 2018-19 Title I Requirement

- 2. Hold parent-teacher conferences (at least two times a year in middle school and high school students) during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement.
 - The school will hold parent-teacher conferences in November and February.
- 3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress. Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:
 - The school will provide reports to parents through annual report cards, progress reports (including IEP progress monitoring), teacher correspondence and copies of standardized testing result
 - Send a letter to any parent whose child is failing in a Core Subject half way through the marking period. Parents will be asked to come in for a conference. Students who get below a 'C" in a Core Subject will be required to attend the after school program for at least the rest of the marking period.
- 4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:
 - The school will provide parent-teacher conferences, school newsletters, hold open houses, parent cafes and conduct evening events related to Math and Reading for parents to attend. Oral and written translation will be provided, if necessary
- 5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities.
 - As written in our Parent/Student handbook, parents are invited to visit Roberto Clemente Charter School at any time. They are to register in the office and wear a Visitor's Pass prior to visiting any classroom. Parent volunteers will be trained to assist in student

learning.


